*“Currently trialling IronCutter® in Melbourne Australia. Both washed sod and sprigs were planted in the third week February, well after optimal planting time. From the outset I knew this variety was something special. It quickly came out of transplant shock and bounced back well, quickly rooting down in a matter of days. The leaf is a brilliant deep green and fine textured, with stolons a beautiful purple contrast. The leaf colour compares very favourably (even against an elite Ryegrass). Inputs to date have been only one granular and one foliar feed and a single treatment of Lexion Intrinsic. As of mid May the colour is still holding well despite significant weather cooling. Considering the timing of planting, the growth to date and the colour has been very impressive. Having seen reports from the US I’m very much looking forward to an early spring green-up and completed establishment once the warmer weather returns. After comparing this green to other similar grasses, it is clear IronCutter® will be the grass I transition to next growing season.”*
